

▲ The Colosseum (Rome, Italy)
Constructed in 80 AD. The long diameter of this large, elliptic colosseum is 189 m, and the shorter is 156 m.

Angel Falls (Venezuela, South America) ►
This huge water fall is in south eastern
Venezuela. It has a drop of 980 m.





▲ The Ganges River (North Eastern India)
This river flows from the Himalayas to the
Bay of Bengal. For the people of India, it
is a place to purify oneself.

Cave (Cappadocia, Turkey) 
Created from the erosion of volcanic rock. It is now Turkey's largest, most famous tourist attraction.







▲ Ayers Rock = Ululu (Northern Australia)
It is the world's largest exposed rock with a circumference of 9 km and a height of 330 m.

▲ The Sahara Desert (Northern Africa)
This desert spreads across central to southern Algeria.
